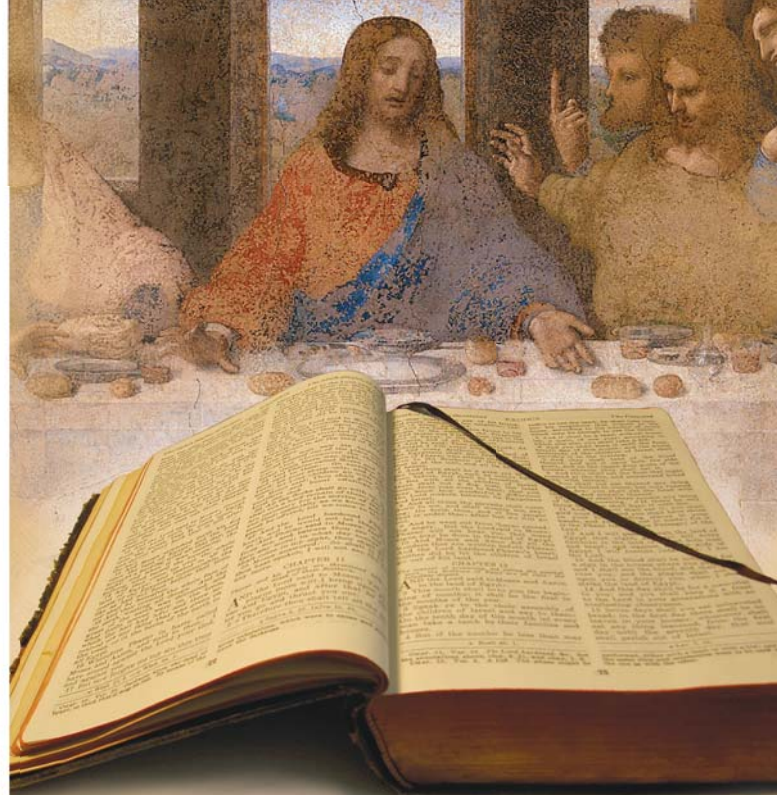

Speakers



DR. SCOTT HAHN
Dr. Scott Hahn has been married to Kimberly since 1979, and has six children. An exceptionally popular speaker and teacher, Dr. Hahn has delivered numerous talks nationally and internationally on a wide variety of topics related to Scripture and the Catholic faith. Hundreds of these talks have been produced on audio and videotapes by St. Joseph Communications. His talks have been effective in helping thousands of Protestants and fallen away Catholics to (re)embrace the Catholic faith. He is currently a Professor of Theology and Scripture at Franciscan University of Steubenville, where he has taught since 1990, and is the founder and director of the Saint Paul Center for Biblical Theology. In 2005, he was appointed as the Pope Benedict XVI Chair of Biblical Theology and Liturgical Proclamation at St. Vincent Seminary in Latrobe, Pennsylvania.



DR. BRANT PITRE
Dr. Brant Pitre is the Donum Dei Professor of Word and Sacrament at Our Lady of Holy Cross College in New Orleans, Louisiana. He received his Ph.D. in Theology from the University of Notre Dame, where he specialized the study of the New Testament and ancient Judaism and graduated with highest honors. He is the author of several articles and a new book, Jesus, the Tribulation, and the End of the Exile, which focuses on the eschatology of Jesus as the key to the origin of the doctrine of the atonement (Baker Academic, 2005). He is currently working on a second book on Jesus and the Jewish Roots of the Eucharist, a project which was funded by a grant from the St. Paul Center for Biblical Theology, founded by Dr. Scott Hahn. Dr. Pitre is an extremely enthusiastic and engaging speaker and has produced several Bible studies on CD, in which he explores the Jewish roots and biblical background of Catholic faith and theology. He currently lives outside New Orleans, Louisiana, with his wife Elizabeth, and their three young children.



PROF. MICHAEL BARBER
Prof. Michael Barber holds a B. A. in Theology and Philosophy from Azusa Pacific University in Southern California and a M. A. in Theology from the Franciscan University of Steubenville in Ohio. Prof. Barber is the author of two books, Singing in the Reign: The Psalms and the Liturgy of God’s Kingdom and, a brand new book, Coming Soon: Unlocking the Book of Revelation and Applying Its Lessons Today. His weekly radio show, Reasons for Faith, is heard on EWTN’s Radio Network every Friday at 11 am Pacific Time. Prof. Barber’s presentations are available from Saint Joseph Communications, Inc.
